NSSWM-2019 has been designated as the official pre-event of the biggest and most popular conference 9th *International Conference on Sustainable Waste Management towards Circular Economy* (9th IconSWM – CE 2019) scheduled during November 27 - 30, 2019 by ISWMAW at KIIT, Bhubaneswar, Odisha. 3. The extended abstract will be published as proceedings books of 9th IconSWM-CE 2019 and the submitted full paper will be selected for publication in books by Springer Nature and special issues of SCI Journals.
4. NSSWM2019 participants (Not for UG students) will be allowed 15% discounted registration fee to 9th IconSWM-CE2019.
5. Awards for Three Best Paper & Three UG Best Poster.

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES: Abstract submission:

1. Make sure that Title is in Times New Roman, font size 14 (Bold), Author's names in font size 12, italicized, font size 10 for full affiliation, email, mobile number/centre aligned.
2. Abstract with four keywords should be of 200 words & extended abstract within 4 pages maximum 1500 words..
3. After completing the above procedure save your file as "LastName- FirstName_ Title of paper" in word's default file format (.docx/.doc) and mail the same to (nsswm2019@gmail.com).

Extended Abstract submission guidelines:

1. The extended abstract should have following subsections: Abstract, Introduction, Materials and methods, discussion and results, conclusions and reference (in APA Format). Maximum 4 pages allowed for each paper.
2. After completing the above procedure save your file as "Paper Id (as will be allocated)" in word's default file format (.docx/.doc) and mail to : nsswm2019@gmail.com.

UG Student Poster Submission Guidelines:

1. Design the poster with minimal textual content in an "A0" size.
2. The poster should have following subsection Introduction, Methodology, Results, conclusions and Reference (in APA Format).
3. Save your file in .pdf file format and mail to: nsswm2019@gmail.com
4. Register by paying the requisite fee and bring your poster printed in flex/paper for display.

Note: Poster under this section will not be included for abstract proceedings book.
